EDUCATION AND OUTREACH

AGE+ continues our 2020 efforts to increase vaccination confidence and access in 16 rural counties of Oregon, thanks to additional OHA funding and new partnerships. The beginning of the year was highly focused on coordinating messaging, mailings, volunteer calls and vaccination scheduling to reach older adults in English and Spanish.

We continue to implement messaging campaigns specific to older adults throughout Oregon—especially in areas with lower vaccination rates.
